What do you mean I need to study?!?!



* reviewing class notes, highlighting key points and summarizing main points (use T-chart or Cornell Notes format)

* reading the textbook and taking notes in your notebook or on note cards (=flashcards)

* creating flashcards or a study guide with key terms and definitions based on your textbook or classroom notes

* making a list of questions about a reading assignment and answering the questions in preparation for a test

* summarizing or paraphrasing textbook or classroom information in your own words

* answering the review questions at the end of a chapter to test your knowledge

* planning how to complete a long project by reading assignment directions, breaking it down into segments (parts), and making a time table with dates by when to complete each part of the assignment

* reading ahead in a class-assigned novel and taking notes

* working on practice materials to prepare for graduation tests in reading, writing, math (ACT, Accuplacer)

* reviewing work corrected and returned by the teacher to identify weak skills you need to improve
